

FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP

November 10, 2020

The regular meeting of the Franklin Township Board was called to order at 7:01 p.m. by Supervisor VanValkenburg. Present: Supervisor Dan VanValkenburg, Clerk Sue Whitehead, Treasurer Terri Moore, Trustees Mike Kelley and Gordon Whelan. Absent: none. The minutes were approved as presented. The Treasurer reported income of \$4,783.56 and expenses of \$36,352.51. One additional bill submitted for approval: John Hancock-\$37.50 (3rd Qt. Part. Fees). Mike moved to approve the report and all bills submitted for payment. Whelan supported. Motion carried 5-0.

OLD BUSINESS

Supervisor VanValkenburg presented additional samples of electronic signs, with a price range of \$16,000 to \$28,000 for the Township hall. VanValkenburg will continue to pursue more pricing.

The new Electrical Inspector Brian Lewis will be paid \$50/Inspection + \$10/Inspection mileage fee + \$10/month phone stipend.

NEW BUSINESS

Zoning Officer Bruce Nickel reviewed the monthly Zoning Report with the Board and gave updates. Nickel reported that 2-Dangerous Building Hearings have been scheduled for December 10, 2020 for structures located at 3310 Paragon Road and 1064 Breyman Hwy.

The Board received a letter of resignation from Jacqueline Benedict effective 12/7/2020. Benedict has cleaned the Township Hall for approximately the last 9 years.

Public comment was offered. Having no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8 p.m.
