

## **June 8, 2010**

The regular meeting of the Franklin Township Board was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Supervisor Platt, who then led the flag pledge. Present: Bob Platt, Sue Whitehead, Nancy Wibbeler, Dan VanValkenburg, and Doug Sherman. Absent: None. The regular minutes and special minutes (5/18/10) were approved as read. The Treasurer reported income of \$130,461.79 and expenses of \$13,658.49. Additional bills submitted for approval: Doug Sherman-\$20.10 (hall light bulbs). From the Bldg. Site Fund: Walter Frazier & Assoc. Professional Surveyors-\$150 (survey & stake new hall property). Motion by Sherman, supported by Whitehead, to approve the Treasurer's Report and all bills submitted for payment. Motion carried.

### OLD BUSINESS

A decision regarding the Michigan Emergency Management Assistance Compact will be discussed at the July board meeting due to the Sand Lake Fire Chief's absence.

Supervisor Platt updated those in attendance that the twp. is seeking an easement on a narrow strip of land that adjoins the new hall property (fronts on M-50) that the twp. was under the impression of owning, and has now come to light that it is actually owned by Curtis Cook. The building plans call for the underground utilities and drain to be placed in that area.

The board discussed Clinton Townships Recycling Center donation request to help with the operation of the center that is available to the surrounding communities. Sherman moved to donate \$600 to the recycling center, VanValkenburg seconded and motion carried.

### NEW BUSINESS

Supervisor Platt read a letter the board received from Doug Gross, President of the Sand Lake Property Owners Assoc. requesting that the twp. pass a Goose Round-up Resolution for Sand Lake. VanValkenburg moved to adopt Resolution #10-1R that requests the Michigan DNR to issue a Canada Goose Round-up Permit to the Sand Lake Property Owners Assoc. Sherman seconded. Roll Call: Sherman-yes, VanValkenburg-yes, Wibbeler-yes, Whitehead-yes, Platt-yes. Motion passed unanimously 5-0.

Resident Glen Mattison inquired as to a twp. sign ordinance and was referred to Bldg. Insp. Bruce Nickel for a sign for the Tipton Community Church. Having no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8:53 p.m.
